Chart 1 - Brent's Out-Borough pupils

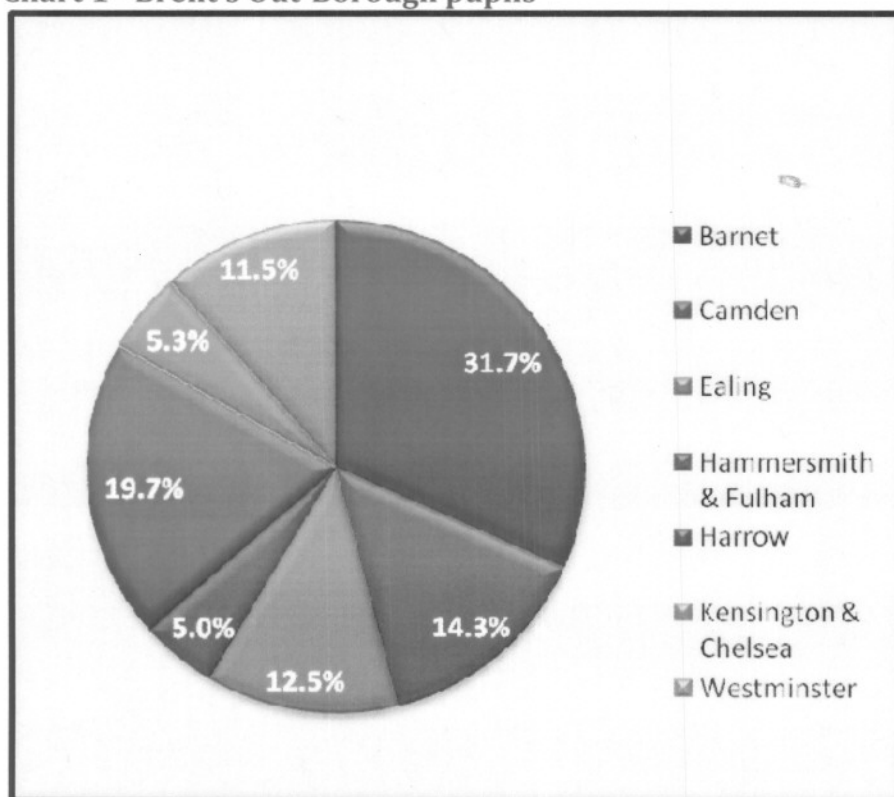

Chart 2 - Brent's Out-Borough pupils by Year Group

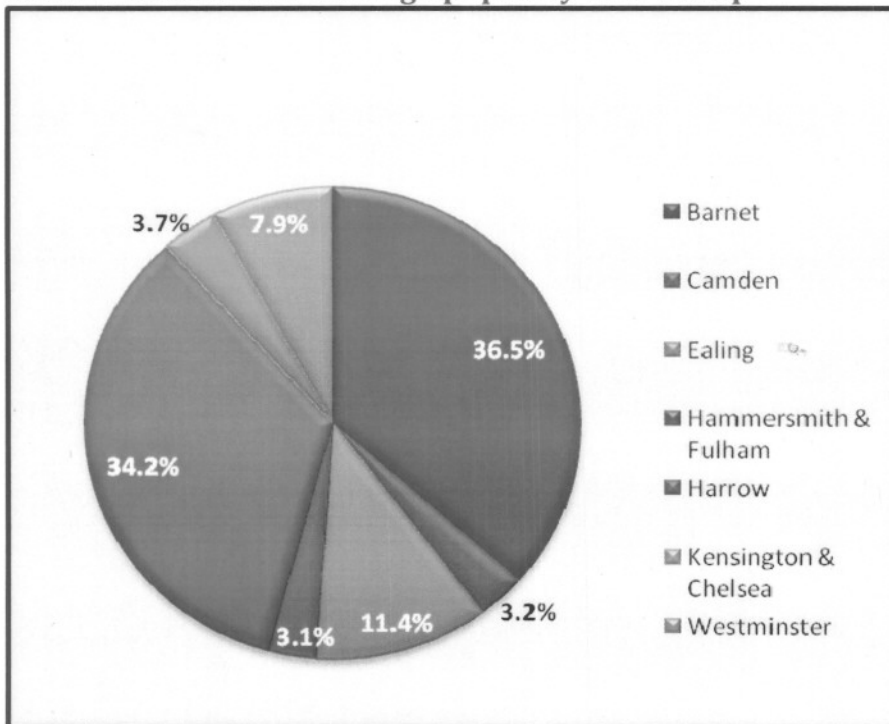
