Thames Water

Many residents and businesses, especially in the Willesden, Bronsbury, Dudden Hill and Mapesbury areas, have suffered difficulties with the flooding of property caused by sewer drains unable to cope with heavy rainfall.

Sewage flooding causes considerable inconvenience and stress for residents and businesses and is potentially hazardous to health. However Thames Water maintains the system is not a priority for replacement. Will the Executive approach Thames Water and encourage them to replace the older drainage system with one better suited to modern usage to stop more residents and businesses from suffering?

Mains water replacement programme

Thames Water are currently undertaking a mains water replacement programme affecting Furness Road, Wrottersley Road, Palermo Road and Odessa Road. These works have been ongoing for over four weeks and are scheduled to finish at the end of October. As a result of these works, residents have been unable to park in their streets and some have been given parking tickets. Residents who have purchased parking permits have lost two whole months out of the 12 they have paid for and so I call on the Council to ensure they are adequately compensated for the months they've lost.
