Proposed Licensable Activities

	Sale of Alcohol (on and off) Late Night Refreshment (indoors)	Opening Hours

Proposed Conditions

1. Food and non-intoxicating beverages, including drinking water, shall be available in all parts of the premises where alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises.
2. Off-sales of alcohol in sealed containers only, except to external areas as defined on a plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Authority.

Prevention of Crime & Disorder

3. CCTV shall be installed to Home Office Guidance standards and maintained in a good working condition and recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to the police and authorised officers from Brent Council.
4. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available for inspection on request to an authorised officer of Brent council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - a) All crimes report to the venue
 - b) All ejections of patrons
 - c) Any complaints received
 - d) Any incidents of disorder
 - e) Any faults in the CCTV system
 - f) Any refusal of the sale of alcohol
 - g) Any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service
5. A copy of the premises licence summary including the hours which licensable activities are permitted shall be visible from the outside of each entrance to the premises.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

6. Customers will not take open drink containers outside the premises except to external areas as defined on the plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Authority.
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Public Safety

8. The total number of people permitted on the premises including staff shall not exceed 150 persons
9. Any locks or flush latches on exit doors shall be unlocked and kept free from fastenings other than push bars whilst the public are on the premises.
10. Any socket outlets that are accessible to performers, staff or the public shall be suitably protected by a residual current device (RCD having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 milliamps).
11. Exits are not obstructed (including by curtains, hangings or temporary decorations), and accessible via non-slippery and even surfaces, free of trip hazards and clearly identified.
12. The locks and flush latches on the exit doors and gates shall be unlocked and kept free from fastenings other than push bars or pads whilst the public are on the premises.
13. The socket outlets (or other power supplies used for DJ equipment, band equipment and other portable equipment) that are accessible to performers, staff or the public shall be suitably protected by a residual current device (RCD having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 milliamps).
14. Where chairs and tables are provided, internal gangways are kept unobstructed

Protection of Children from Harm

15. A sign stating "no proof of age - no sale" shall be displayed at the point of sale.
16. A "Challenge 25" policy shall be adopted and adhered to at all times in respect of the sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises, including when alcohol is delivered by off sale.

Additional major events conditions:

17. On major football event days at Wembley Stadium the following shall apply:
 - a) At least **[1]** SIA registered supervisor shall be on duty until 30 minutes after the premises is closed for licensable activities.

- b) The DPS will work in partnership with the Police and if necessary comply with a direction given by a member of Brent Police Licensing or a senior Police officer on duty at the event.
- a) All drinking vessels shall be polycarbonate/paper or made from other non-glass material.
- b) External areas shall not be used.
