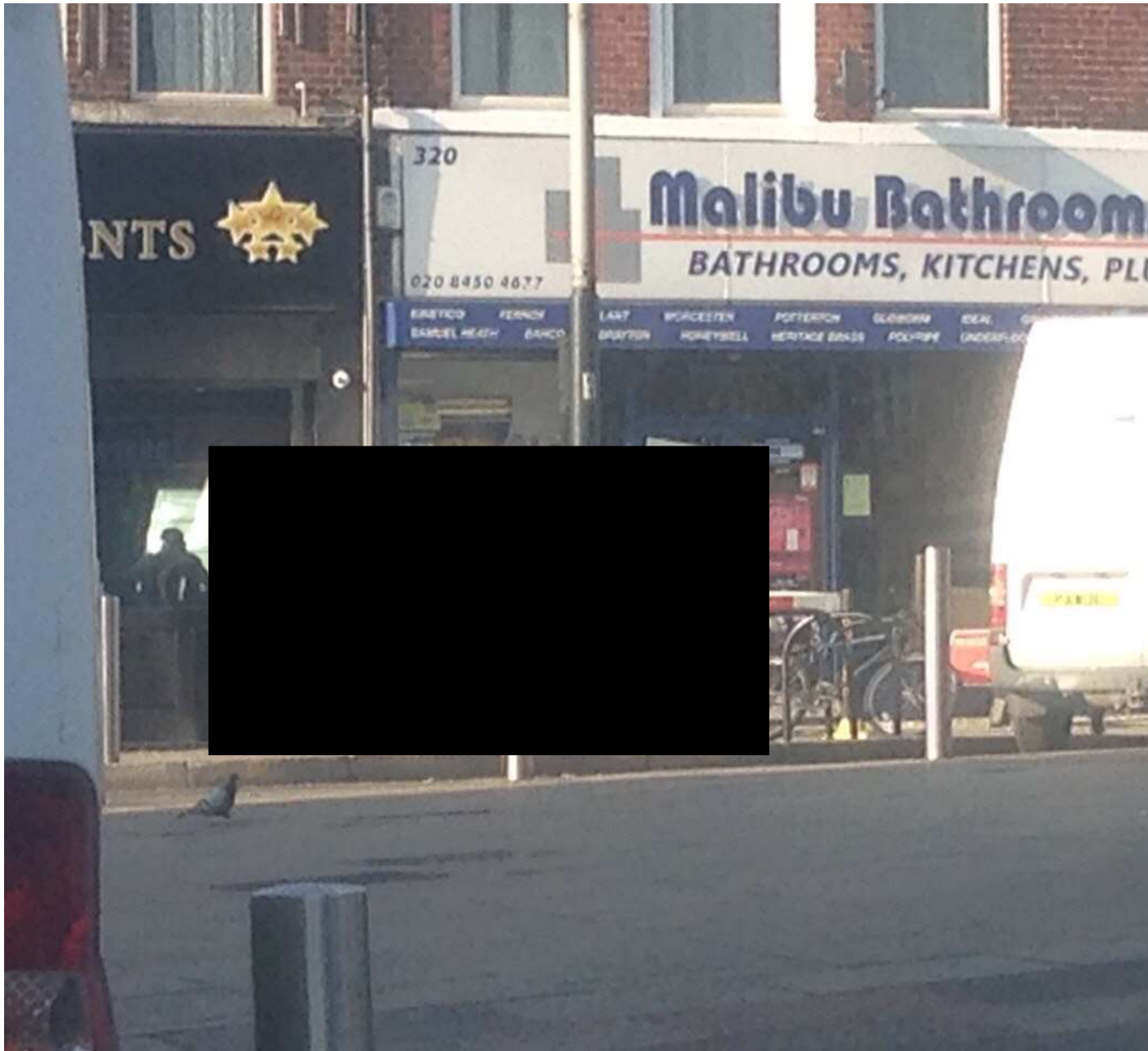

I hope you will take my points I mentioned above into consideration when reviewing the off licence.

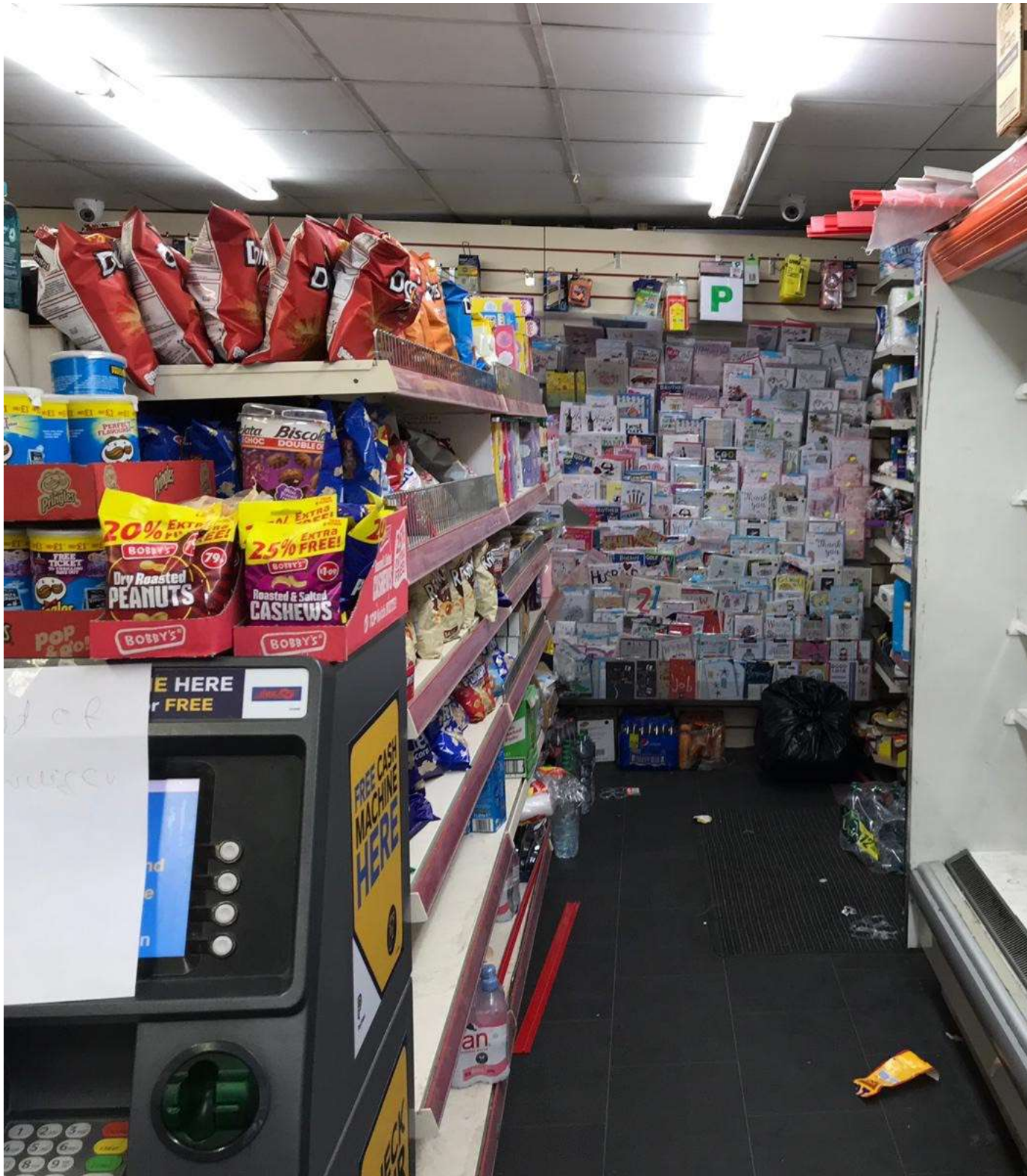
I have attached some pictures of the empty selves and street drinkers .I have also attached a article about drinking problem and homelessness.
