

This staff member must be able to show a Police or authorised council officer recent data or footage with a minimum of delay when requested (in accordance with Data Protection legislation)

- 3. Each member of staff authorised to sell alcohol will receive adequate training on the law with regard to alcohol sales. All training will be properly documented and retained. The training records will be kept on the premises and made available for inspection by authorised officers.
- 4. The premises will operate a "Challenge 21" policy whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 21 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age. Acceptable identification for the purposes of age verification will include a driving licence, passport or photographic identification bearing the "PASS" logo and date of birth. If the person seeking alcohol is unable to produce acceptable means of identification, no sale or supply of alcohol will be made to that person. Challenge 21 signage shall be displayed within the premises.
